

Introduction to Fashion & Textile Technology



What are the aims of this course?

This Course offers learners opportunities to develop a range of skills including practical construction skills. Learners will develop a range of practical skills in producing textile items that offer opportunities for personalisation and choice. They will also develop appropriate and safe use of relevant tools and equipment to manufacture straightforward fashion/textile items. This is underpinned with the relevant knowledge of textile properties and technologies required to create fashion/textile items.

What will I be learning about in this course?

Safety using fabric technology equipment
Different types of fabric/sewing skills
How to follow patterns and assemble fabric items

What skills will I develop?

Plan, make & evaluate a product to a given brief
Organise resources & equipment to carry out a practical activity
Develop practical skills through fabric activities

What learning and teaching approaches will I experience?

Practical fabric demonstrations, group & paired work, visits to and from outside agencies.

How will I be assessed?

Assessments will be ongoing while carrying out fabric activities on practical abilities

What are the homework requirements?

Homework will be issued in Teams and will be related to learning in the classroom.
