

S4 National 4 Hospitality Skills for Work

What are the aims of this course?

This course has been designed to provide an introductory qualification in hospitality which reflects the initial skills required for the hospitality industry.

Places are limited due to placement restrictions.

Entry is at the discretion of the Home Economics Department.

What will I be learning about in this course?

Working in the Hospitality Industry Working in the Professional Kitchen Working Front of House Introduction to Events

Pupils also have the opportunity to achieve the Elementary Food Hygiene certificate to prepare them for hospitality placements. This course requires £40 to cover practical lessons

What skills will I develop?

It will enable pupils to develop general and practical skills, knowledge and understanding, together with employability skills and attitudes needed to work in the hospitality industry.

What learning and teaching approaches will I experience?

It will be delivered in partnership with school, colleges, employers and other training providers. Visits to outside agencies, employment places, hospitality or catering establishments Visitors/speakers in school

How will I be assessed?

Assessments to be completed throughout units and placements Ongoing observation assessments Observation checklists to be carried out in placements

What are the homework requirements?

Homework will be on a regular basis.

What might this course lead to in the future?

Can lead to Hospitality National 5, Practical Cake Craft National 5 or other college related courses. Employment in the hospitality, catering or food production industries.
